1.) Nursery school

- ▶ from 3 to 6 years old

2.) Primary school

- ▶ from 5 to 11 years old
- ▶ 20 children in each class
- ▶ 1 lesson of literacy and numeracy every day



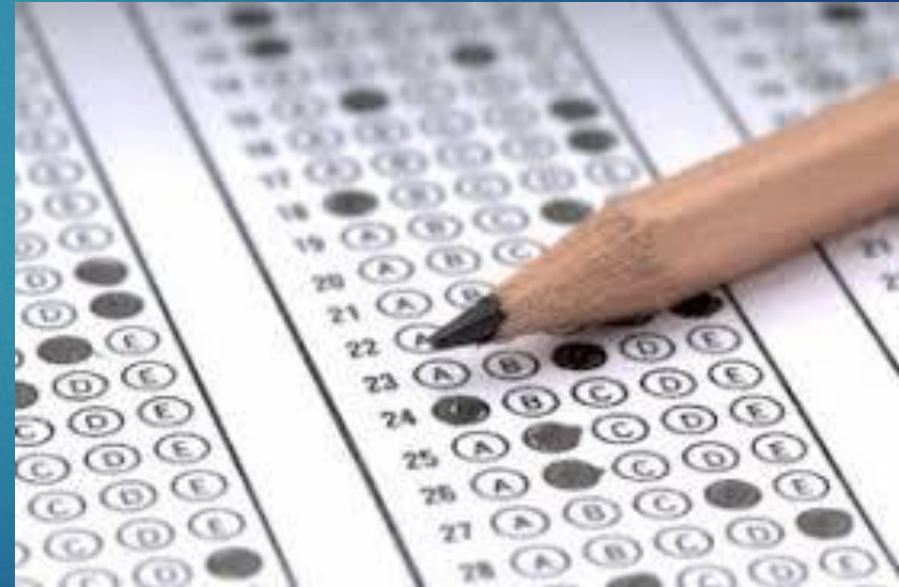
3.) Secondary school

- ▶ from 11 to 16 years old
- ▶ they have to wear uniform

- ▶ state school in UK follow national curriculum



4.) Examinations

- ▶ after 16 students take GCSE exams
- ▶ 70% of students then continue to higher education



5.) Higher education

- ▶ going to university is very expensive in UK
- ▶ universities teach by lecturers and seminars
- ▶ at the end of their courses students pass their final exams and graduate

- ▶ In South Korea, high school students have double shifts every day that makes for around 12-13 hours at school.
- ▶ There is a rotation system in South Korea in which teachers change schools every five years.
- ▶ Japanese schools teach Moral Education at par with other subjects like Mathematics.
